The Astronomy Laboratory Schedule above is SUBJECT TO CHANGE. A total of 10 labs must be done for full credit of the lab component of the course. The 11th lab will be considered extra credit. Students MUST do at least 8 labs to pass the course. You may also submit one or both

of the *take-home* labs (lab 4 or 25) for additional extra credit. The take-home labs must be submitted by the week of November 10 to receive credit. Note that students can do no more than 12 labs total for credit. There are no individual make-ups for the lab. If you miss a lab, the 11th evening lab or one of the take-home labs can be used as a make-up.
